Approval of Minutes

July 2017 Meeting Minutes were approved unanimously.

Staff Reports

Arborist Report

- 75 Tree Removal Permits were issued for the month, with 100 having been submitted.
- The Alpha Loop project has begun.

Environmental Programs (Terry Porter)

- The Fall calendar has not yet been finalized.
- Two Grants may be available for our application. One is for development of an edible community orchard, and the second is for creation of a pollinator garden. The NRC will visit some of our new park locations in Alpharetta to look for sites to accomplish one or both of these.
- Rivers Alive is scheduled for September 30th and will need NRC volunteers to help.

Committee Reports

Alpharetta's Wild Side Update:

- Alpharetta has been certified as the 105th NWF Certified Community Wildlife Habitat in the U.S. The next steps will be a Press Release notification and a community celebration of the accomplishment. Ideas were discussed for both.

- Joe Lamp'I will present 'Fall Vegetable Gardening in Atlanta' at his home and garden on Saturday October 21st.
