IV. REPORT IN BRIEF:

Staff is requesting program funding in an amount totaling \$24,000.00 to the North Metro Miracle League (NMML) for athletic, recreational, cultural, social, and educational programs aimed at improving the lives of disabled children and adults and their families. Specific programs include Camp Moe-Mentum, Camp 2 Community, and the After School Fitness program. This funding will help ensure additional individuals will be able to participate in NMML activities and programs. Funding is coming through available recreation program funding within the Operating Grant Fund.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"), made and entered into this ____ day of April, 2018, by and between the City of Alpharetta Recreation, Parks and Cultural Services Department, acting by and through its authorized officials signing below (hereinafter called "City"), and North Metro Miracle League, Inc., a Georgia nonprofit corporation (hereinafter called "NMML"), acting by and through its authorized officials signing below.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, City provides and conducts a variety of recreation and cultural activities that benefit the disabled citizens of the City in a wholesome and constructive manner; and

WHEREAS, NMML provides athletic, recreational, cultural, social and educational programs aimed at improving the lives of disabled children and adults and their families including, but not limited to, Camp Moe-Mentum, Camp 2 Community and the NMML After School Fitness programs at the NMML Sports Complex and Learning Center within the City's North Park; and

WHEREAS, Camp Moe-Mentum is an inclusive four week, five days per week, camp in June of each year, concentrating on fitness and fun (ages range from 4 to 21) which the City desires to support monetarily to allow additional disabled children and/or teens to participate. Campers of all abilities participate in a variety of activities which encourage movement and socialization. Children and/or teens from the community volunteer to be Buddies and model appropriate behavior while participating in a variety of activities. Camp Moe-Mentum is an entry level program but includes newcomers and returning veteran campers. The daily schedule replicates the typical school day so campers remain in that mind set during the summer break; and

WHEREAS, Camp 2 Community is a four week, Monday through Friday, summer program for disabled children and teens aimed at providing meaningful life, social and vocational instruction while maintaining the stress free and fun environment of a typical summer camp which the City desires to support monetarily to allow additional disabled children and teens to participate. Campers ages 10 through 16 learn many valuable life skills throughout the summer session; and

WHEREAS, NMML conducts an After School Fitness Program on Mondays and Wednesdays for disabled children and teens at the City's North Park facility during the Fulton County school year and the City desires to support said program monetarily so as to make it available to additional disabled children and teens.

WHEREAS, Camp Moe-Mentum, Camp 2 Community and the NMML After School Fitness programs shall be part of ongoing City programs open to all adults and youth; and

WHEREAS, NMML conducts these programs at the City's North Park facility and engages participation from individuals without regard to race, religion, creed, nationality, or orientation; and

WHEREAS, City would like to ensure that as many disabled children and adults and their families are able to participate in NMML activities and programs as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises above and the promises below, the parties mutually covenant and agree as follows:

1. NMML shall provide the Camp Moe-Mentum, Camp 2 Community and the NMML After School Fitness Program as outlined above and otherwise agreed to by the City and NMML.
2. City shall pay NMML the sum of \$24,000 (\$8,000 toward each of the above programs) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 in consideration of NMML's services as set forth herein.
3. City shall include NMML information on the City website and other appropriate advertising as agreed to between the parties.
4. City shall not be financially responsible for NMML operations and equipment (unless owned by City).
5. It is agreed and understood that NMML releases the City, its agents and employees from any and all damage or injury to participants or property arising out of performance of this MOU and that NMML shall relieve the City of all damages, liabilities, expenses and losses incurred by the City as a result of NMML's performance of the MOU.
6. If NMML defaults on any obligation under this MOU or violates any term or condition, the City may terminate the MOU.
7. If the City defaults on any obligation under this MOU or violates any term or condition, NMML may terminate the MOU.
8. Either party may terminate this agreement with 90 days written notice.
9. This MOU may be modified only by a written agreement between City and NMML.
10. It is agreed between City and NMML that this MOU shall be executed in multiple counterparts, which may be used for any purpose for which the original may be used.
11. City has designated the Director of Recreation and Parks or his designee as its contact person, coordinator, and liaison person with NMML in the execution of the terms of the MOU.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the person(s) executing this contract represent(s) that they are an officer or director of their entity, and that they have the lawful authority to make and enter into this MOU on behalf of their respective entity. The parties have hereunto set their hands the day and year first above written:
