- Mr. Akly stated Food Terminal is a full-service Asian restaurant with 2 other locations located in Georgia. The Alpharetta location will be their 3rd location. The owners have over 30 years of restaurant experience.
- All staff are trained using the TIPS ServSafe training. They also address over-serving and checking all ID's in their employee manuals.
- Mr. Akly confirmed the owner is aware their servers will need to obtain pouring permits. The owners are familiar with the City of Alpharetta alcohol laws.
- Mr. Akly was reminded to submit naturalization documents for the owner and registered agent to Lauren Shapiro, City Clerk, as soon as possible. He will need to

reach out to the State of Georgia directly for their naturalization document requirements to obtain a State license.
