- Ms. Audrey Stine and Mr. Connor Boney, co-owners of Cleaver & Cork, were on the call.
- Ms. Stine described Cleaver & Cork as an artisan butcher shop selling meats, seafood, and cheeses. They currently have 2 other locations in Georgia in Newnan and Sharpsburg. They plan to sell bottles of wine and craft beers.

- Ms. Stine stated she is familiar with the City of Alpharetta's alcohol ordinance and is aware they are required to obtain a State of Georgia alcohol license as well.
- Ms. Stine stated that currently, her employees are all 21 years and older. They are trained to check IDs of anyone looking 70 years and younger, all alcohol is bagged and unopened and there are no underage pickups of alcohol allowed.
- City Attorney Stacy recommended the application be approved. He advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear at the City Council meeting on Monday April 18, 2022 at 6:30 pm.
