- Clarice Nesbitt and Rick Nesbitt of VinoRita, LLC residing at 2780 Manor Bridge Drive, Alpharetta, GA 30004 were both present on the call.
- Ms. Nesbitt explained they will serve wine slushies. They will work with local wineries, offer non-alcoholic kid slushies and partner with local food businesses to provide dessert foods.
- Ms. Nesbitt confirmed this is their first location. The lease with Avalon has not yet been finalized. Ms. Shapiro explained that if the location space on the application is changed

within Avalon, they will need to file an amendment. If they move outside of Avalon, they will need to file a new application.

- Mr. Nesbitt stated they are hoping to open June 1.
- Mr. Nesbitt confirmed they have read through the alcohol ordinances for Alpharetta.
- Mr. Nesbitt stated he is aware employees taking orders and serving alcohol will need pouring permits. They will also familiarize themselves and the employees with the ordinances of serving alcohol.
- Ms. Shapiro reminded the applicants they will need to acquire a State of Georgia alcohol license once the local Alpharetta license is issued.
- Ms. Nesbitt asked Ms. Shapiro to confirm the hours of Sunday Sales.
- Ms. Shapiro recommended the application be approved. She advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear at the City Council meeting on Monday May 16, 2022 at 6:30 pm.
