- Mr. Hussein "Shan" Sultan of 2876 Overlook Way, Atlanta, GA 30324, is owner and registered agent of Liquor Emporium and was on the call.
- Mr. Sultan explained this liquor store will focus on high-end beers and wine, as well as standard liquor. This is a new business.
- Mr. Sultan plans to open the store by end of year. Mrs. Shapiro explained after this license is issued, City Ordinance states that the business will open within 6 months. If it does not, she explained Mr. Sultan will need to reach out to the City with an update.
- Mr. Sultan confirmed he is familiar with the City's alcohol ordinances. He also added he expects to have 2 employees to start and up to 4 employees during high peak season(s).

- Mr. Sultan is also the owner of the convenience store at the Shell Station near this location. He has a company that trains his employees on local alcohol ordinances and selling alcohol. This company also performs "Mystery Shop" drop in's at all of his locations to confirm employees are adhering to the rules of selling alcohol.
- Mrs. Shapiro recommended the application be approved. She advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear at the City Council meeting on Monday May 23, 2022 at 6:30 pm.
