- Alcohol serving training will be in house. Mr. Hamilton confirmed all employees will obtain pouring permits to serve alcohol.
- Ms. Shapiro reminded Mr. Hamilton they will need to obtain a State of Georgia alcohol license as well.
- Ms. Shapiro recommended the application be approved. She advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear in person at the City Council meeting on Monday June 6, 2022 at 6:30pm.
