Natural Resources Commission Meeting Minutes

May 17, 2022

I. Call to Order

- a. Meeting called to order @7:10 pm.

II. Roll Call and announcements

- a. Present were Clay Jones; Geri Chapple; Kate Tunison; Ben Manley; Beth Ott; Dan Mitnick; David Shostak; Terry Porter; and Arata Watanabe.

III. April 2022 Meeting Minutes

- a. April meeting minutes were accepted.

IV. Arborist Report

- a. Arborist report was not given as David Shostak was not present.

V. Keep Alpharetta Beautiful/Environmental Programs

- a. Date for the Rain Barrel Workshop has been changed to June 25, 2022.
- b. November 11, 2022; is National Take A Hike Day. There was discussion about collaborating with Anna Virgo, Alpharetta Recreation and Parks Department. A public offering is possible the following Saturday. The Commission wants to let Anna know we are interested in partnering.
- c. Arata asked about Alpharetta having their own recycling center. Roswell only allows Roswell residents to use theirs. We spent significant time discussing recycling and landfills. It is not a profitable industry.
- d. Seniors that have health issues can request a back door pickup for trash and recycling. Alpharetta will also pick up bulky waste items free of charge through online request.

VI. Committee Reports

- a. Ben indicated that our budget is \$1,500.00 not \$2,000.00. We have until 6/30/22 to purchase and have items delivered to apply cost to 2022 budget. There is \$331.00 to spend. We decided to purchase insulated bags.
- b. Volunteers are needed to do the farmers market for the Great American Camp Out – 8:30am to 12:30pm. Beth will chair, and Ben will help. They will attempt to get a sponsor to join. Mountain High is likely. We hope to have a booth at the farmers market July 9, 2022. Geri will help to develop a QR code to help advertise the NRC.
- c. We are to advise Terry who is available on June 18 and June 25 to help with the household hazardous waste collection and Great American Camp Out.
