- Pan Kim, applicant for CBS 2500 Old Milton, LLC was on the call. Home address for the applicant is 4864 Ruby Manor Circle, Buford, GA 30518.
- The restaurant was described as American-style dining serving hamburgers, wings, salads and side items.
- It was stated there is one other location in Suwanee, GA that is not currently serving alcohol yet. This is their 2nd location which opened in June 2021.
- It was stated they are familiar with the city's alcohol ordinance.
- There are approximately 8 full-time employees and a few part-time employees.
- Managers will be taking alcohol orders at the register counter. There will be no table service.

- Ms. Shapiro reminded the applicant that pouring permits are required and can be obtained through the City of Alpharetta's Public Safety Department.
- Ms. Shapiro also reminded the applicant they are to also obtain a state of Georgia alcohol license once they receive the local license.
- Office Frank Jackson confirmed the application has gone through a background check and has met the qualifications for obtaining a local license.
- Ms. Shapiro recommended the application be approved and placed on the Consent Agenda at the Monday, July 25, 2022, City Council Meeting. She advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear in person at the meeting.
