- Mr. Bobby Kim, applicant for Toscana Ita, LLC and residing at 2451 Lockerly Pass, Duluth, GA 30097, was on the call.
- Mr. Kim described the business as an American Steakhouse & Seafood restaurant.
- Ms. Castro also added that this is a high-end steakhouse. She said this is their first restaurant.
- Ms. Castro added the restaurant plans to open at the end of October or first part of November 2022.
- Ms. Shapiro reminded the applicant and registered agent the restaurant needs to be open and doing business within 6 months of obtaining the local alcohol license.

- Ms. Castro confirmed they are familiar with Alpharetta's local alcohol ordinances.
- Ms. Castro said they anticipate 30 employees who will be serving alcohol and is aware they will need to obtain a pouring permit. Alcohol training will be handled by the General Manager. Ms. Shapiro reminded Ms. Castro that she, as well as the General Manager, will need to obtain a pouring permit as well.
- Ms. Shapiro explained once the local Alpharetta license is issued, it will be uploaded to the State Revenue Portal so they are able to obtain their state license.
- Ms. Shapiro recommended the application be approved and placed on the Consent Agenda at the Monday, October 17, 2022, City Council Meeting at City Hall. She advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear in person at the meeting.
