- Ms. Dana Resnick, Esq. of Sard & Leff, Inc. located at 3789 Roswell Road, Atlanta, GA 30342 was on the call representing the applicant.
- Ms. Resnick stated this restaurant is going in the location formerly occupied by Chili's Restaurant. This is the 2nd First Watch location in Alpharetta, GA.
- Ms. Resnick stated this location plans to open Monday, December 5, 2022 and will not be serving alcohol until they acquire the required licenses.

- Ms. Resnick stated First Watch is open 7 days a week from 7a.m. – 2:30p.m. and serves breakfast and lunch. Their sales are primarily 95% food and 5% alcohol.
- Ms. Resnick stated employees will be trained on the service of alcohol using ServSafe and are instructed to ask for ID for anyone appearing under than 40 years of age.
- Ms. Shapiro had Ms. Resnick confirm the applicant is familiar with the City of Alpharetta's alcohol ordinances and noted they will need to obtain their state of Georgia license as well before serving alcohol.
- Code Enforcement Officer Frank Jackson confirmed the applicant has met all the requirements of obtaining an alcohol license in the City of Alpharetta. Ms. Shapiro then recommended the application be approved. She advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear in person at the City Council meeting on Monday, December 5, 2022 at 6:30 pm.
