- Mr. Divyesh Shah, owner and registered agent for AK Alpha Enterprise, LLC residing at 653 Citation Trail, Milton, GA 30005, was on the call.
- Mr. Shah explained this is a change of ownership at the store. The current owner does have an alcohol license.
- Mr. Shah has been involved in convenience stores located at gas stations for over 25 years. He used to own the Shell station on Alpharetta Highway in Alpharetta.
- Mr. Shah stated he is familiar with the City of Alpharetta's alcohol ordinances.
- Mr. Shah stated there will be 3 other employees, plus himself, who will be working at the store.

- Mr. Shah stated alcohol training consists of a scanning system. If alcohol is being purchased, it is scanned and prompts for identification. The employee scans the ID or verifies by entering the date of birth from the identification.
- Ms. Shapiro reminded Mr. Shah that once the local City of Alpharetta alcohol license is obtained, he must still obtain an alcohol license from the state of Georgia.
- Officer Smith confirmed that City staff has reviewed the application and that it meets all the City's requirements for an alcohol license. Ms. Shapiro recommended the application be approved and advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear in person at the Alpharetta City Council meeting on Monday, February 20, 2023, at 6:30 pm in case Mayor or Council have any questions.
