- Mr. Michael Hartshorn, territory manager for RNR RCMH, LLC and residing at 473 Edwards Court, Lawrenceville, GA 30044 was on the call.
- Mr. Hartshorn stated this is a sushi and hibachi restaurant with digital entertainment including tracks of live music and music videos. They are open for business.
- Mr. Hartshorn stated there are 62 locations throughout the Southeast, including one in Duluth.

- Mr. Hartshorn stated there are approximately 18 employees at this Alpharetta location, including a host/hostess seating customers and servers who wait on tables. There is dining in and patio seating available.
- Mr. Hartshorn stated employees are given a general alcoholic beverage training from their corporate team. Management will train on local ordinances.
- Mr. Hartshorn confirmed he is aware all employees, including himself, are required to have a pouring permit obtained through the Alpharetta Public Safety Department.
- Ms. Shapiro reminded Mr. Hartshorn that once he obtains his local license, he will need to obtain a license from the State of Georgia before they begin serving alcohol.
- Officer Smith confirmed that City staff has reviewed the application and that it meets all the City's requirements for an alcohol license. Ms. Shapiro recommended the application be approved and advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear in person at the Alpharetta City Council meeting on Monday, February 27, 2023, at 6:30 pm in case Mayor or Council have any questions.
