- Ms. Sujeanna McNeil, owner and applicant for Golden Gaubugi, LLC and residing at 2912 Cherry Laurel Lane, Norcross, GA 30071, was on the call.
- Ms. McNeil stated Hole in the Wall Sushi is a small family-owned sushi restaurant.
- Ms. McNeil stated this is her first business in Alpharetta and that they are currently open.
- Ms. McNeil stated they have approximately 5 employees and only 1 will be pouring and serving alcohol. Ms. McNeil is familiar with the City's alcohol ordinance.

- Ms. McNeil stated only 1 employee (her mother) will be handling and serving alcohol and that she will be checking IDs so they do not serve anyone under age.
- Ms. Shapiro reminded Ms. McNeil that once the local license is issued, a state license will need to be obtained before they can begin serving alcohol.
- Officer Smith confirmed that City staff has reviewed the application and that it meets all the City's requirements for an alcohol license. Ms. Shapiro recommended the application be approved and advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear in person at the Alpharetta City Council meeting on Monday, April 17, 2023, at 6:30 pm in case Mayor or Council have any questions.
