- Ms. Mindy Thompson of Sard & Leff, LLC located at 3789 Roswell Road, Atlanta, GA 30342 is representing the applicant and was on the call. Mr. Marcel Van Rooijen, Vice President of Flik Hospitality and residing at 400 Tavern Circle, Sandy Springs, GA 30350, was also on the call.
- Ms. Thompson stated Flik International is a related business of the Compass Group, which is an International corporate dining service. There are several other companies under the

Compass Group providing similar service to other corporate locations throughout Georgia, including the Mercedes-Benz campus, Norfolk-Southern and the Equifax headquarters in Atlanta, all of which hold alcohol beverage licenses. Flik will be providing corporate dining service for the Equifax location in Alpharetta for their corporate meetings and after-hours meetings/events.

- Ms. Thompson stated Flik will be operating an on-site cafeteria, but will not be offering alcoholic beverages for purchase. The alcohol will strictly be available for meetings or after-hours socials for employees.
- Ms. Thompson explained Flik will not offer off-site catering, this is for the Equifax campus in Alpharetta only.
- Mr. Van Rooijen stated there are 9 associates who will be working and are TIPS or ServSafe trained. If more servers are needed for any large events, they would hire TIPS or ServSafe Trained servers. Ms. Shapiro reminded Mr. Van Rooijen that anyone serving alcohol would require a pouring permit from the City of Alpharetta.
- Officer Jackson confirmed that City staff has reviewed the application and that it meets all the City's requirements for an alcohol license. Ms. Shapiro recommended the application be approved and advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear in person at the Alpharetta City Council meeting on Monday, May 22, 2023, at 6:30 pm in case Mayor or Council have any questions.
