- Ms. Dana Resnick of Sard & Leff, LLC located at 3789 Roswell Road, Atlanta, GA 30342 is representing the applicant and was on the call. Mr. Kyle Ziegler, Assistant Manager for Snooze, an A.M. Eatery, at 6065 North Point Parkway, Suite 230, Alpharetta, GA 30022 was also on the call.
- Ms. Resnick stated Snooze, an A.M. Eatery is a restaurant and will be serving breakfast, brunch and lunch food. They plan to open at the end of June.

- Ms. Resnick stated there are currently three Snooze, an A.M. Eatery, locations in Georgia – two locations in Atlanta and one location in Sandy Springs, all having no violations.
- Ms. Shapiro reminded the applicant that this application is contingent upon receiving fingerprint background reports for two officers listed on the application. Ms. Resnick confirmed the fingerprinting has been completed and will be sent to the Fieldprint processing facility today.
- Mr. Ziegler confirmed the employees will be TIPS Certified and have pouring permits. Snooze, an A.M. Eatery also conducts in-house training and requires all customers to produce ID when ordering alcohol. There is also a three-drink maximum per person rule in place.
- Ms. Shapiro reminded the applicant that once the local alcohol license has been issued, they will need to obtain a license from the State of Georgia as well.
- Officer O'Donnell confirmed that City staff has reviewed the application and that it meets all the City's requirements for an alcohol license. Ms. Shapiro recommended the application be approved and advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear in person at the Alpharetta City Council meeting on Monday, June 19, 2023, at 6:30 pm in case Mayor or Council have any questions.
