- Ms. Taqua Scoon, Reconciliation and Permitting manager for JK North Point Management, LLC residing at 2970 Clairmont Road, Suite 945 Atlanta, GA 30329 was on the call.
- Ms. Scoon stated the change in ownership for the hotel took place in late 2022.
- Ms. Scoon stated they still have the same General Manager although lower-level staff may have had some turnover.
- Ms. Scoon stated alcohol will be served from a small bistro on the first floor. It is a sit-down area and a limited restaurant.

- Ms. Scoon stated the General Manger is aware of the local alcohol ordinances.
- Ms. Shapiro reminded Ms. Scoon they will need to obtain a state license once the local license from Alpharetta is issued.
- Ms. Scoon is aware employees must maintain a city pouring permit to serve alcohol and that a list will be on site for any inspections.
- Officer O'Donnell confirmed that City staff has reviewed the application and that it meets all the City's requirements for an alcohol license. Ms. Shapiro recommended the application be approved and advised the applicant that a representative will need to appear in person at the Alpharetta City Council meeting on Monday, August 21, 2023, at 6:30 pm in case Mayor or Council have any questions.
