Approval of Minutes

Staff Reports

1. Environmental Programs (Terry Porter)
 - The Sustainable Gardening Workshop held at Whole Kids Garden on April was very well attended and enjoyed by participants.
 - Completed a Household Hazardous Waste and Paint Recycling Collection April 1.
 - A Computer and Electronics Recycling and Community Shredding event was held April 8th at Public Safety.
 - Upcoming programs for April and May include:
 - Three Workshops: “Establishing and Growing Perennials,” “Container Gardening” and “Maintaining and Pruning Shrubs.” To be held at Public Works.
2. Arborist Report
 - A Council vote on the proposed Tree Ordinance changes is expected May 1st.
 - 138 tree cutting permits were issued in the past month.
 - The Arborist office is working with developers to preserve more trees in the design phase of projects.

Committee Reports

Alpharetta’s Wild Side Update:

- As of April we have only 18 more points needed to achieve City certification. A new contest has been initiated with the prize being the remaining premium yard sign.
- Howard and Rhoopsha spent time at Rockmill Park to introduce Greenway users to her App.
- A decision was made to postpone asking Joe Lamp’l to do his pollinator broadcast for us this fall. Will try to schedule it in spring.

Adopt-A-Mile Program Revision and Logo Development

We will be convening the project committee to revisit next steps which will likely be to hire an illustrator to develop logo concepts.
